Ruins & Nature

After an early breakfast, your private driver and certified guide will pick you up for a journey to Muyil, a peaceful ancient Mayan city hidden in the jungle and dating back to 350 ACE. Explore its temples, climb the mirador for panoramic views of the Sian Ka'an Biosphere, and enjoy a scenic walk through mangroves to the Muyil Lagoon.

There, board your private boat and cruise through ancient canals once used by the Maya for trade. These waterways lead to the Chunyaxché Lagoon, fed by underground rivers. At a historic customs house, you'll disembark for a serene float down a natural canal, surrounded by orchids, mangroves, and the sounds of nature.

After about 40 minutes of floating, walk back through the white mangrove savannah and return by boat to your vehicle. The day ends with a delicious taco lunch at Tacos Onorio, a local favorite in downtown Tulum.

The Maya: Past & Present

After a restful night, embark on a special journey to the ancient Maya city of Cobá, nestled in the jungle. Once a major political center covering over 70 square kilometers, Cobá offers the choice of exploration by foot or bicycle, guided through its impressive ruins and rich wildlife, including monkeys, toucans, and possibly jaguars.

Following the tour, visit a local Maya family to experience their way of life. Learn about the Melipona bee, a stingless native species producing rare, citric-flavored honey prized by top chefs. Discover its cultural importance and endangered status.

Then, participate in a hands-on cooking session to prepare a traditional Maya meal, which you'll enjoy with your hosts—an opportunity for genuine cultural exchange.

Finally, return to your hotel for a relaxing afternoon at your leisure.

Today, you'll explore three distinct types of cenotes—open, semi-open, and underground—each representing a different geological age. You'll swim and snorkel in these beautiful, lesser-known locations, chosen for their tranquility, stunning rock formations, and magical atmosphere, with opportunities to see unique fish and impressive stalactites and stalagmites.

After a refreshing swim and a delicious lunch, your day continues with one of Mexico's most profound spiritual experiences—a Maya temazcal ceremony. Led by a shaman in a traditional igloo-like steam lodge, this ritual cleanses the body and spirit through heat, aromatic herbs, and guided meditation. Many describe it as deeply transformative—a moment of introspection and renewal.

A day of natural wonder and ancient wisdom awaits.
